

The Finnish Association of Translators and Interpreters (SKTL) requires its members to uphold the status and reputation of the profession by meeting the following requirements of good professional practice:

- 1. Translators deliver texts that are fit for purpose and meet the client's needs, ensuring that the content and style of the source is reliably transferred to the target language and culture.
- 2. Translators are bound by confidentiality regarding any information they acquire in the course of their work concerning the person commissioning the work and other persons or entities.
- 3. Translators do not seek in any way to benefit financially from what they learn in the course of their work.
- 4. Translators do not intentionally harm their fellow professionals.
- 5. Translators maintain and develop their professional skills.
